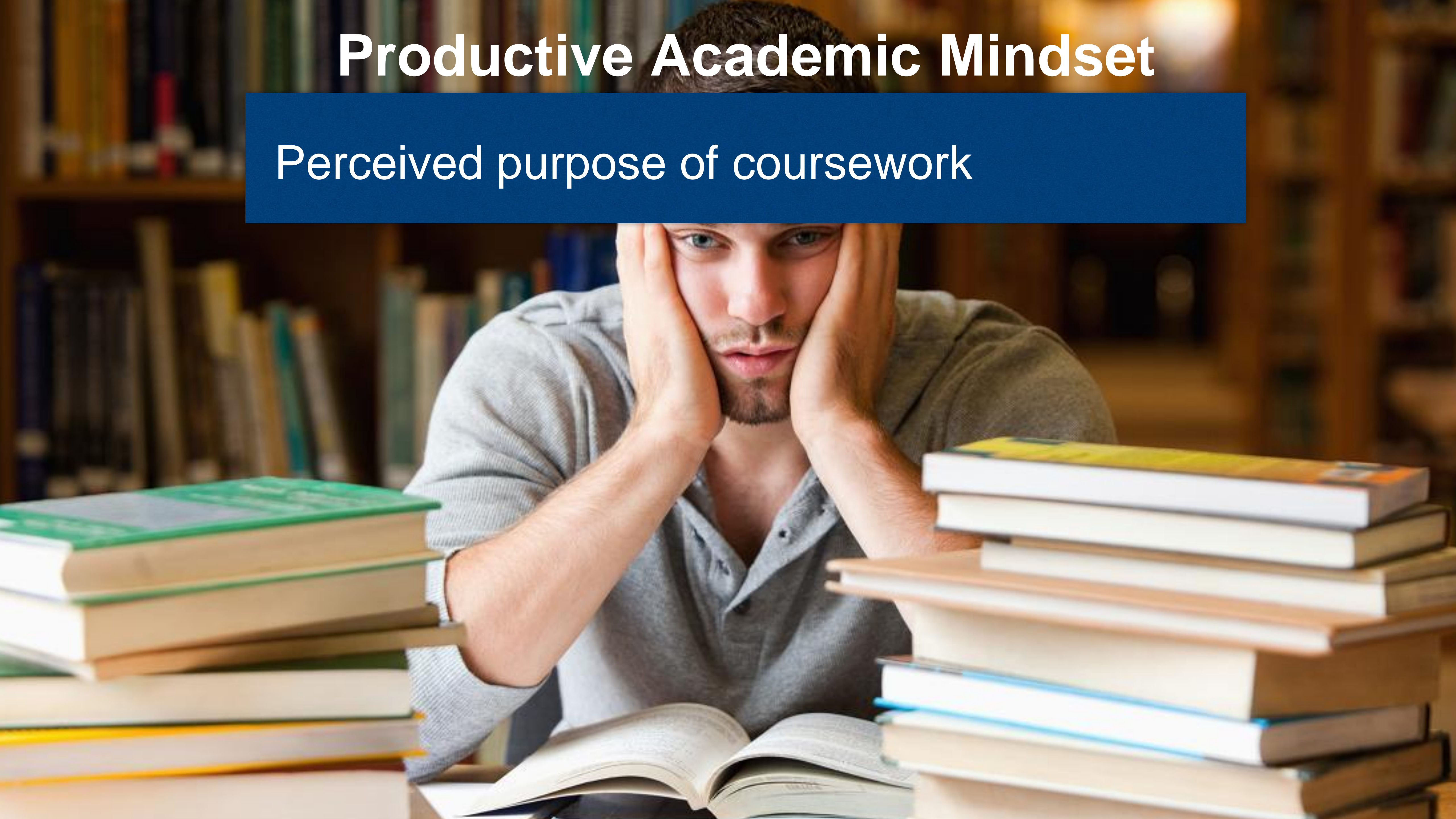

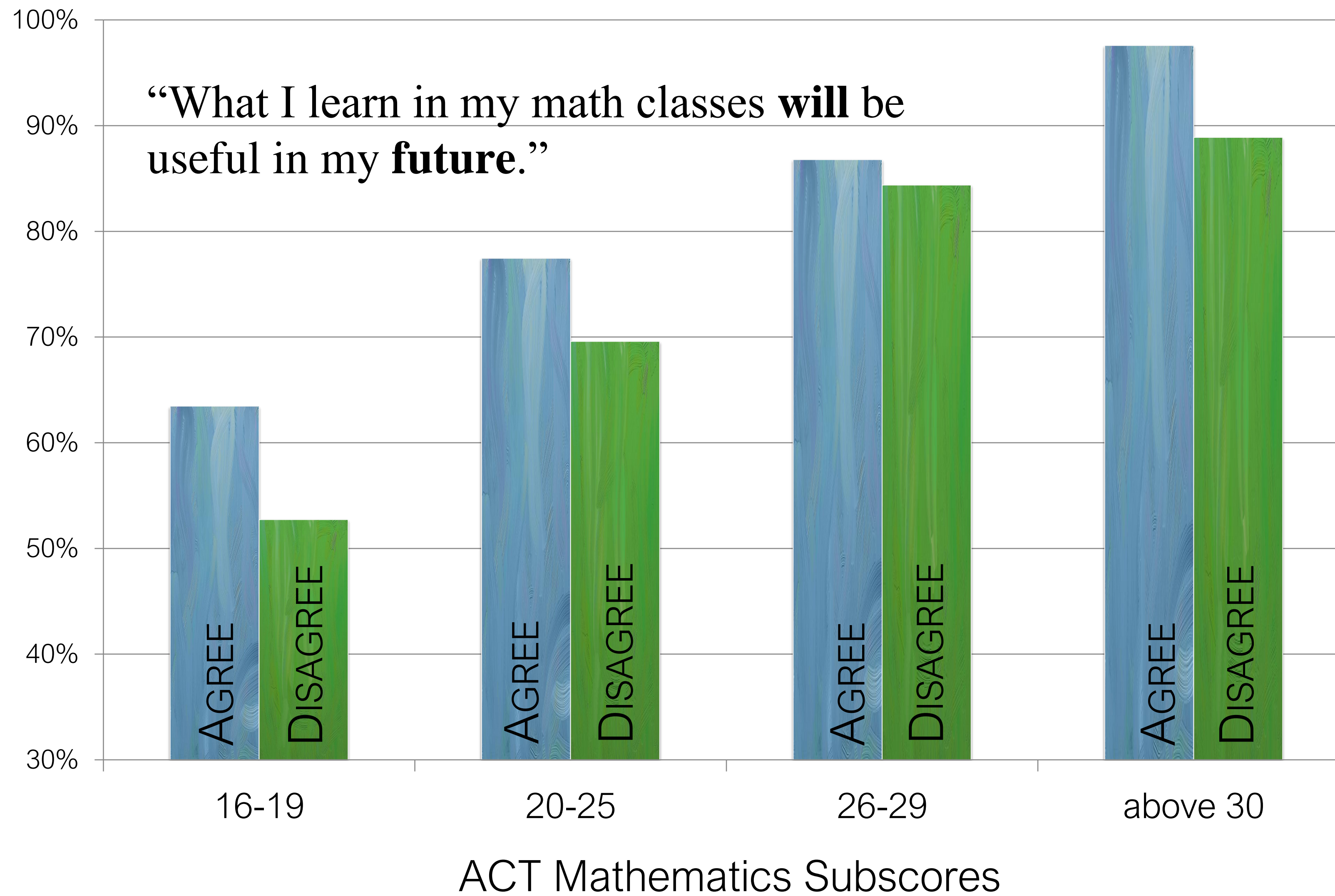

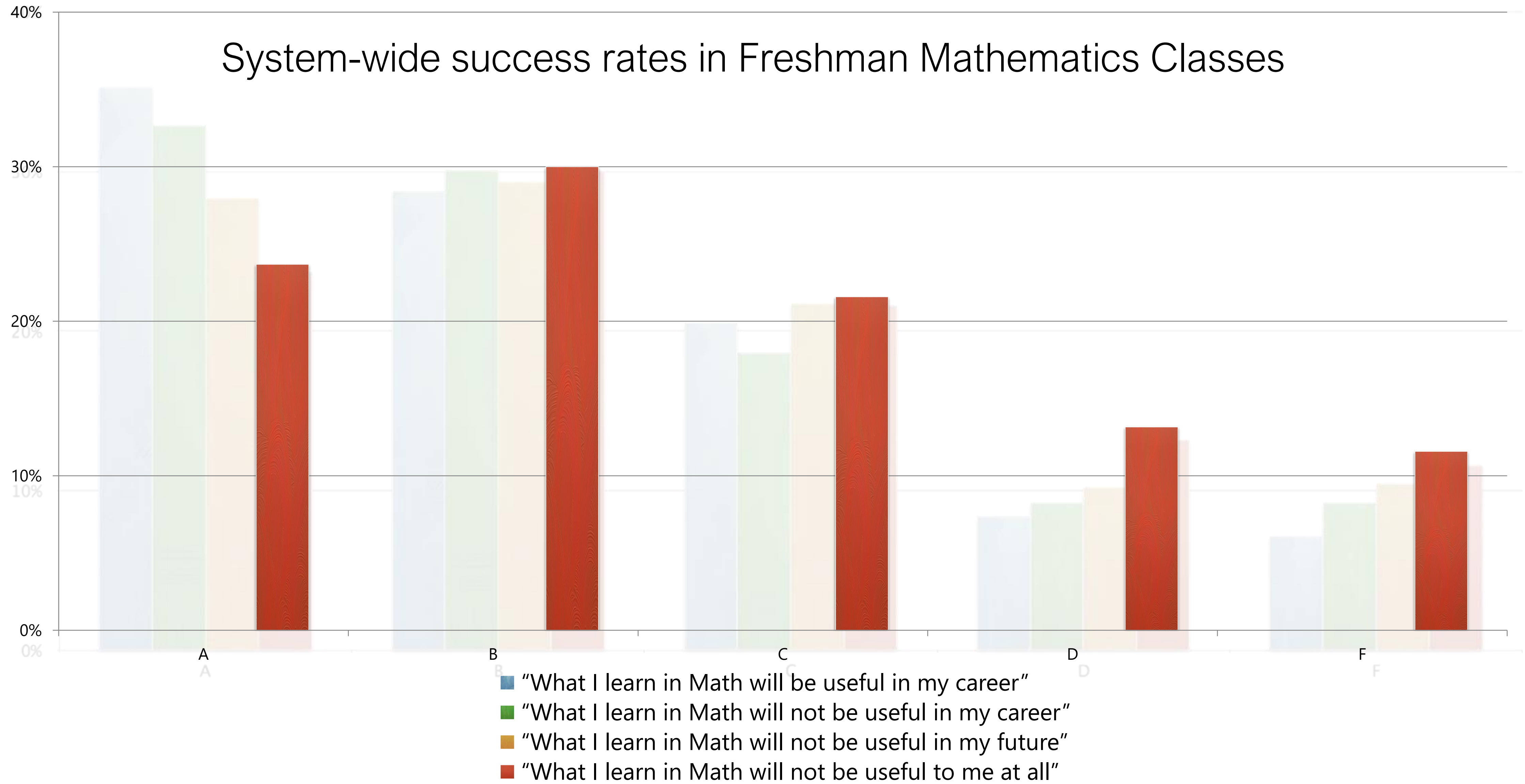
System-wide success rates in Freshman Mathematics Classes



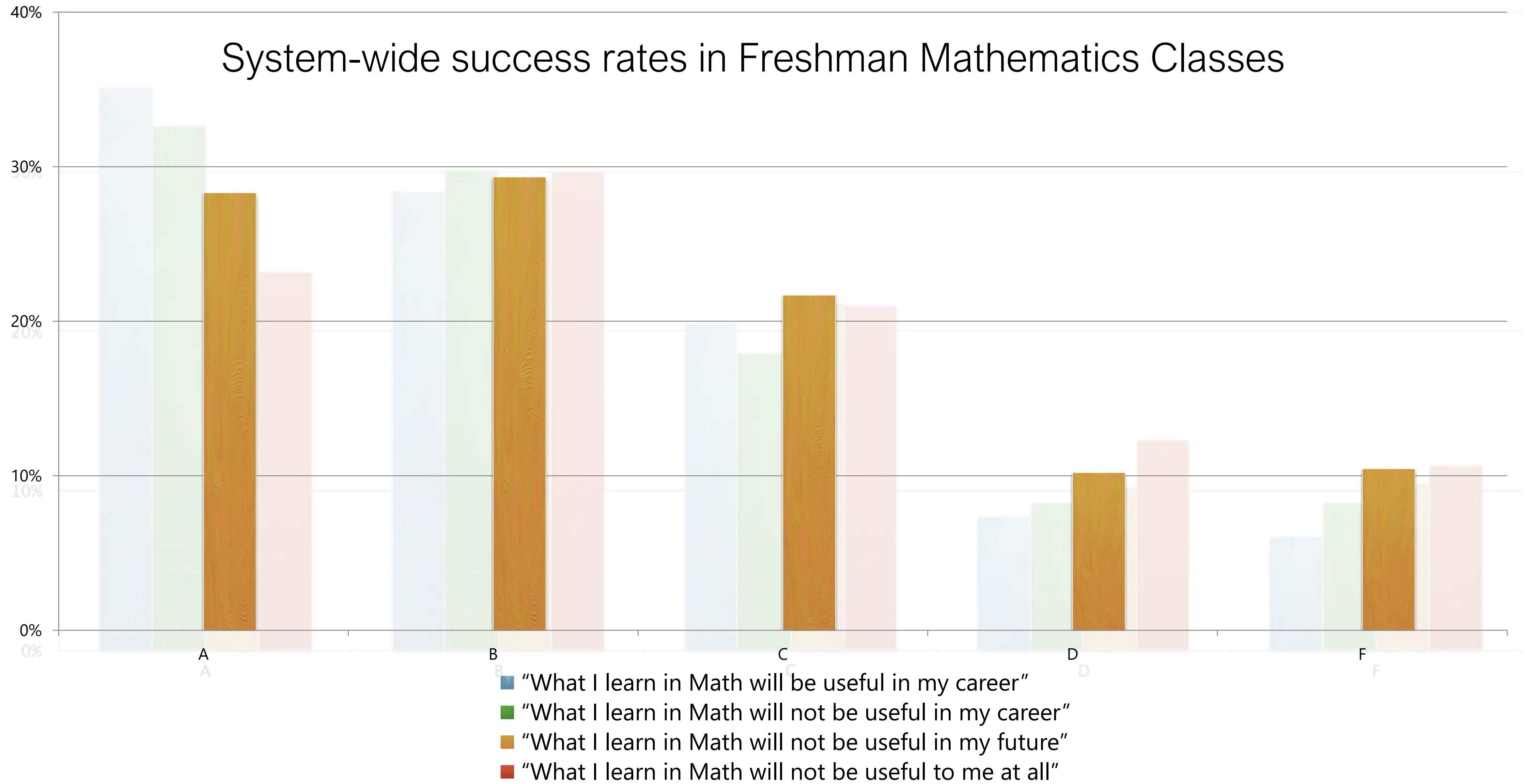

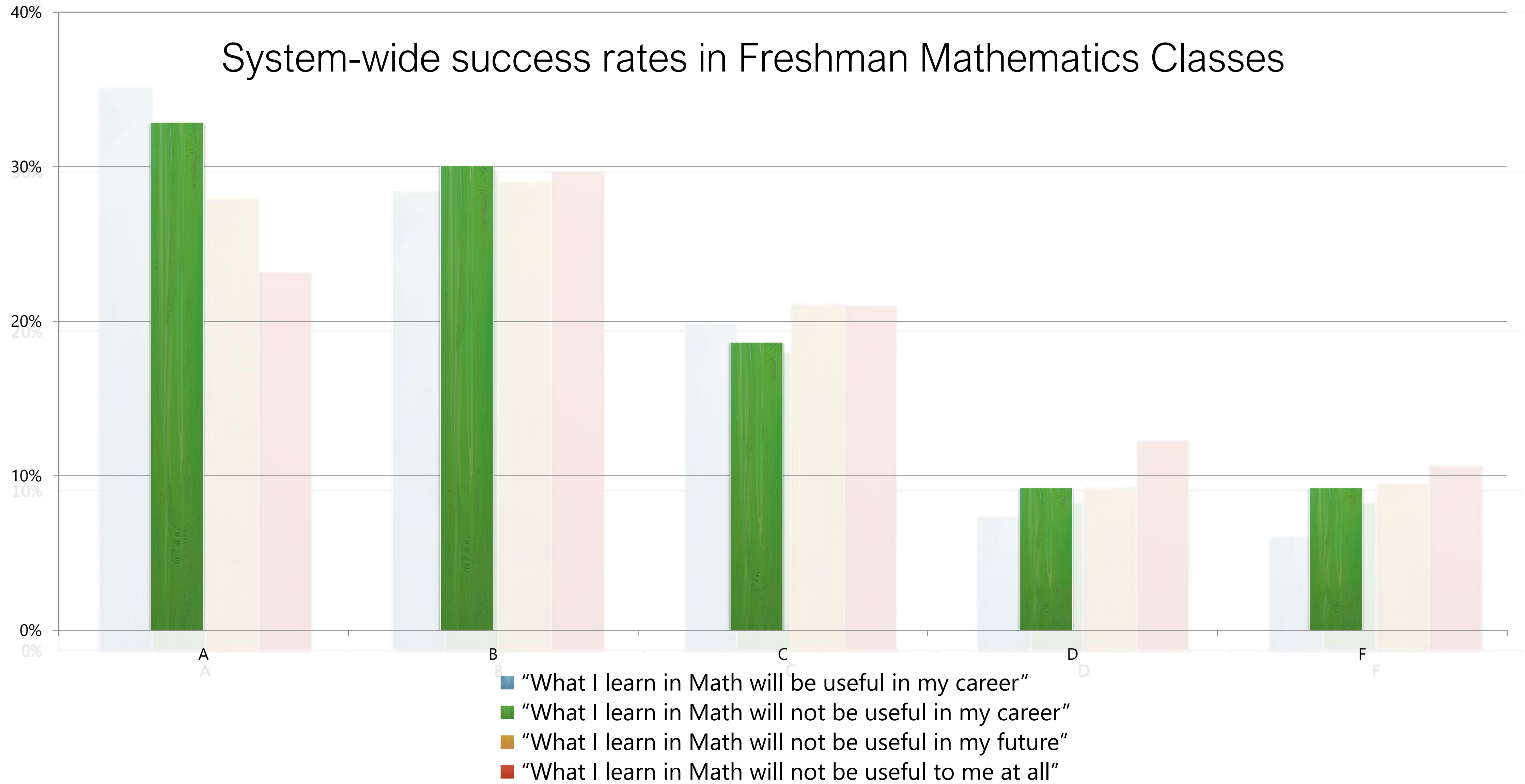

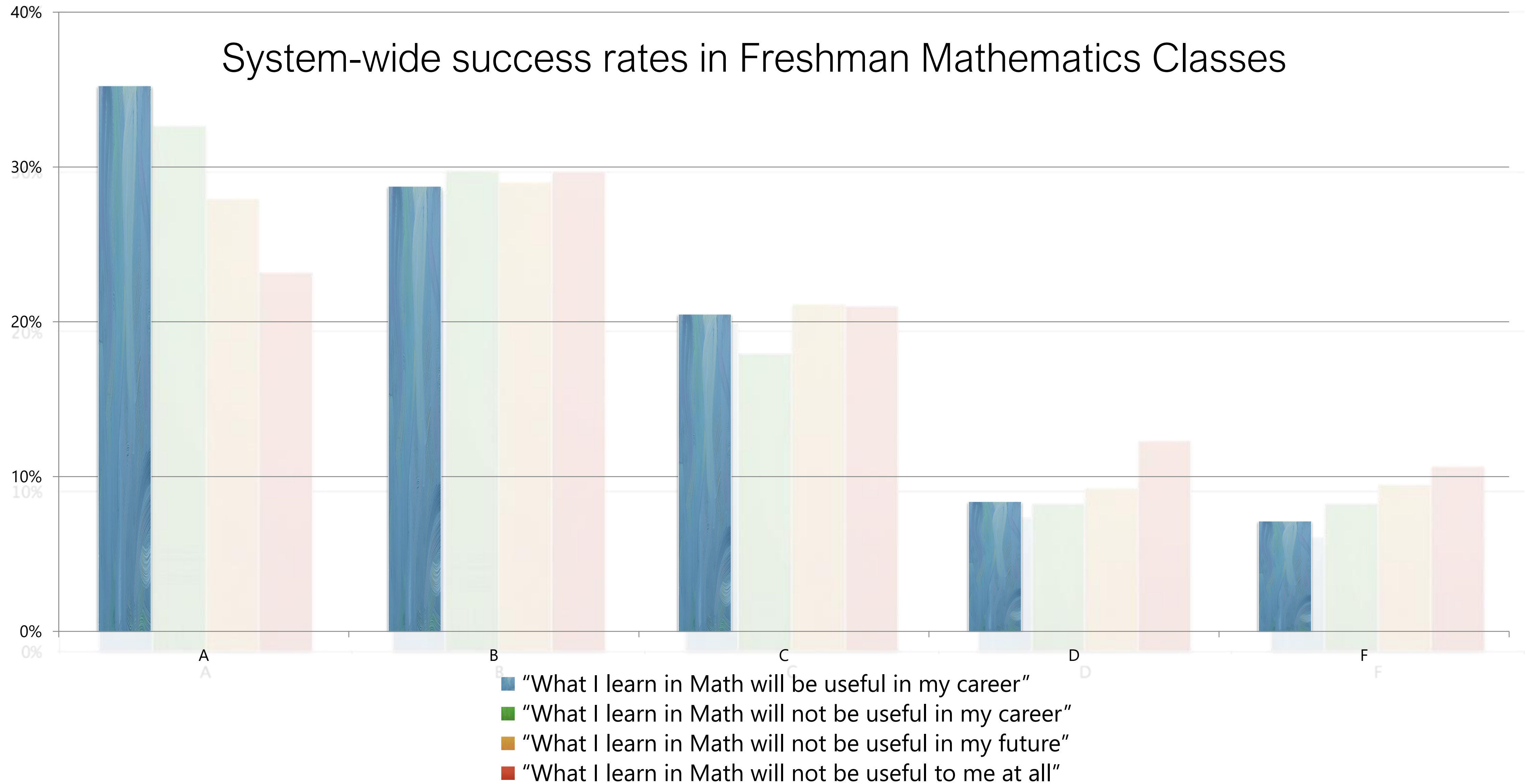

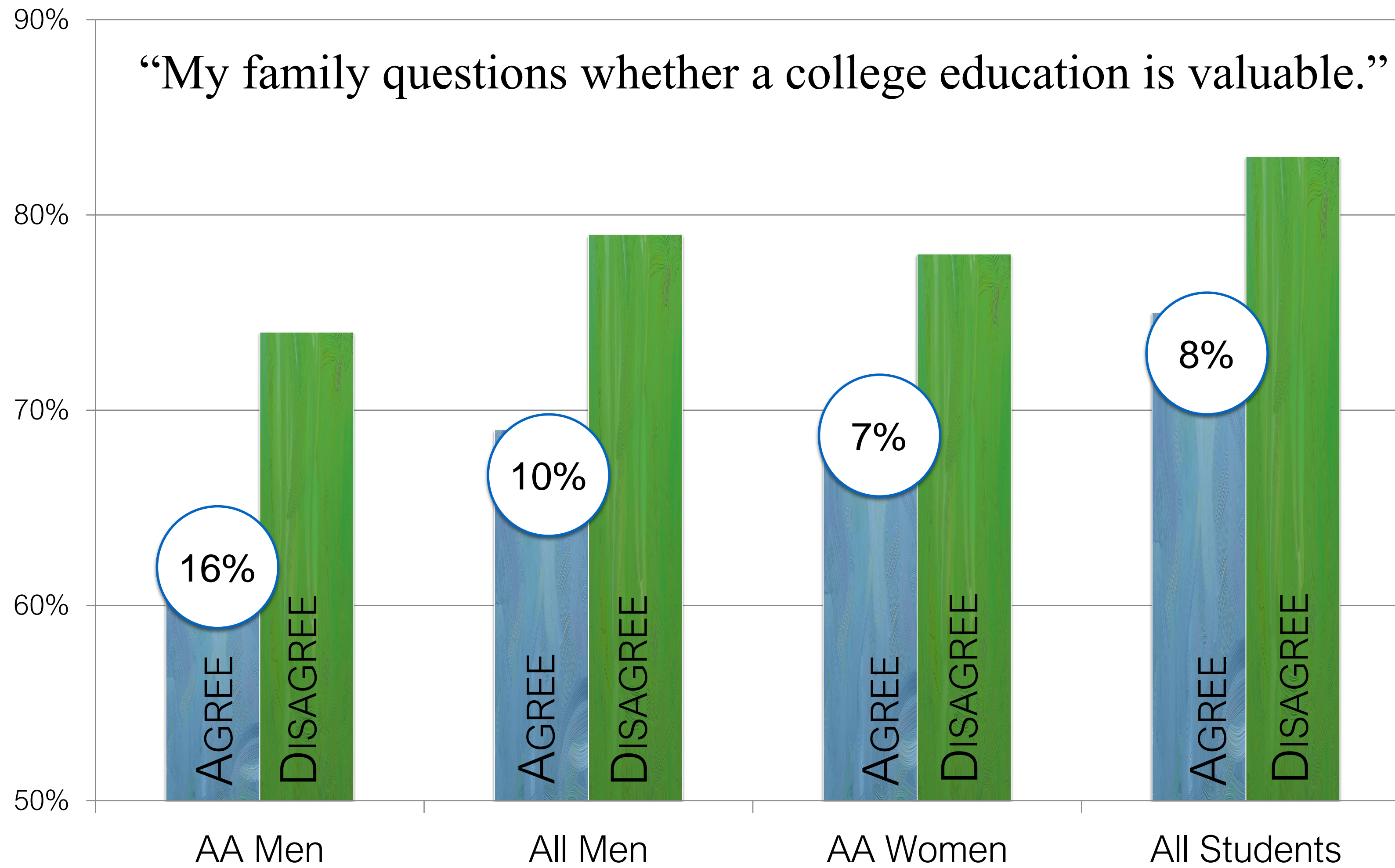
System-wide Earned Hour % in Freshman Classes

System-wide Earned Hour % in Freshman Classes



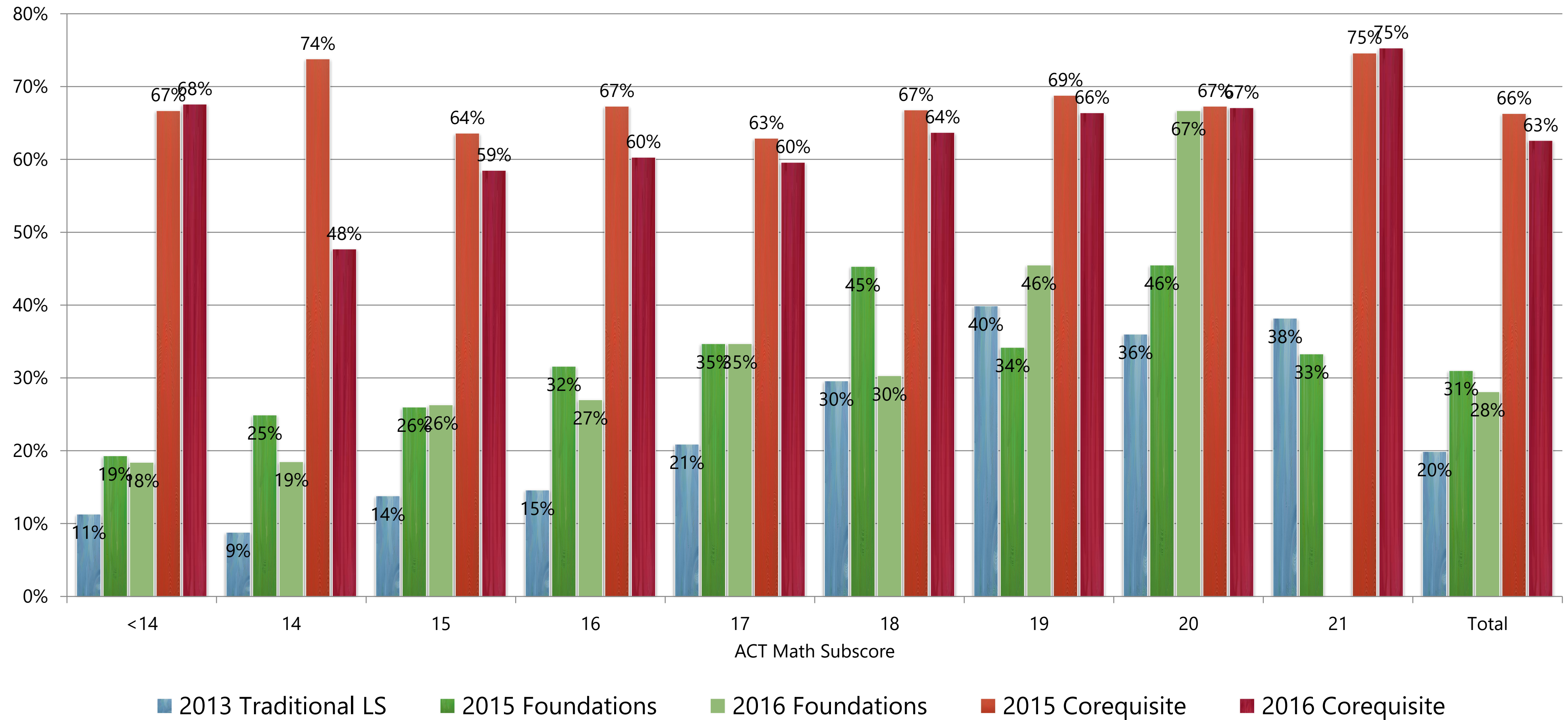

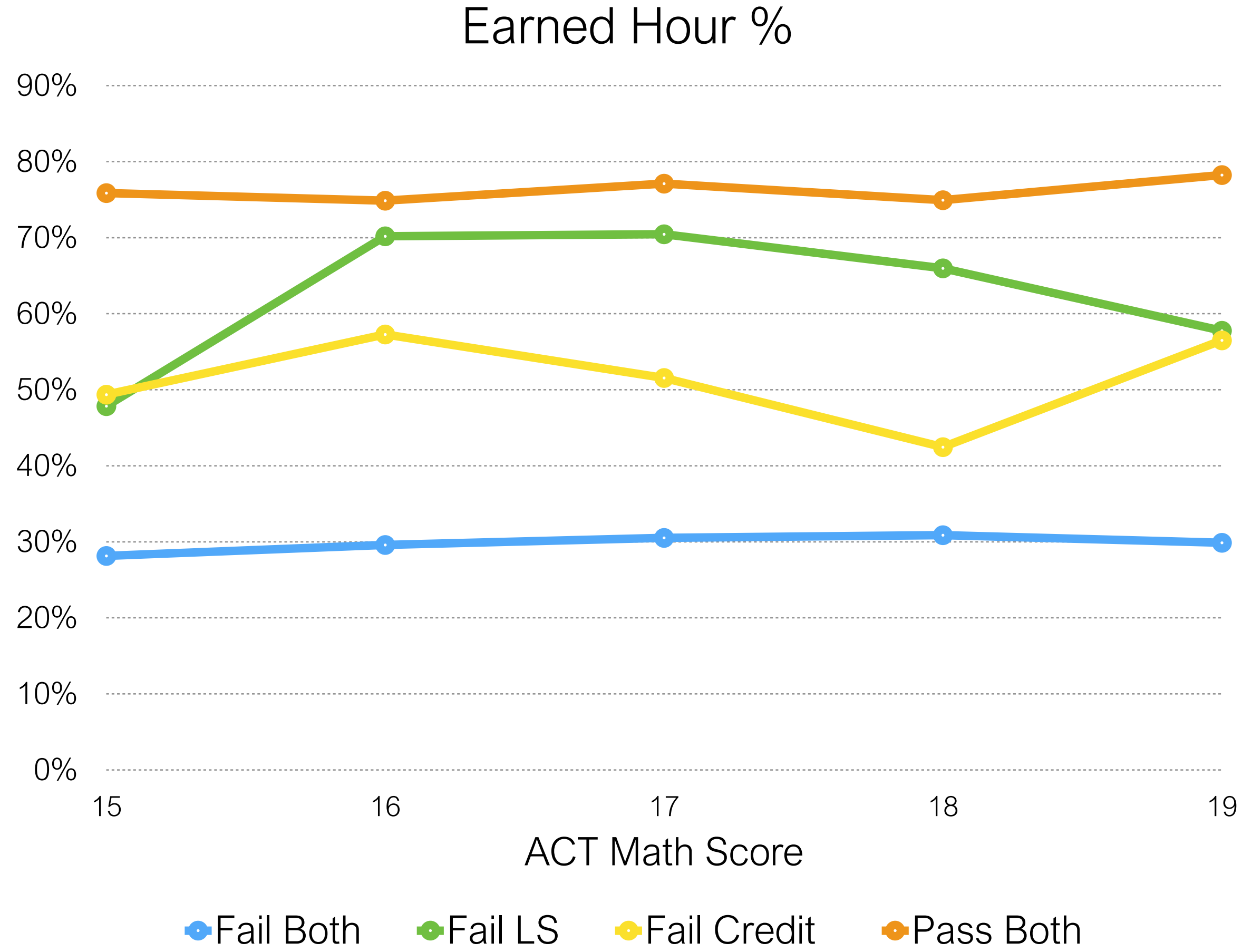
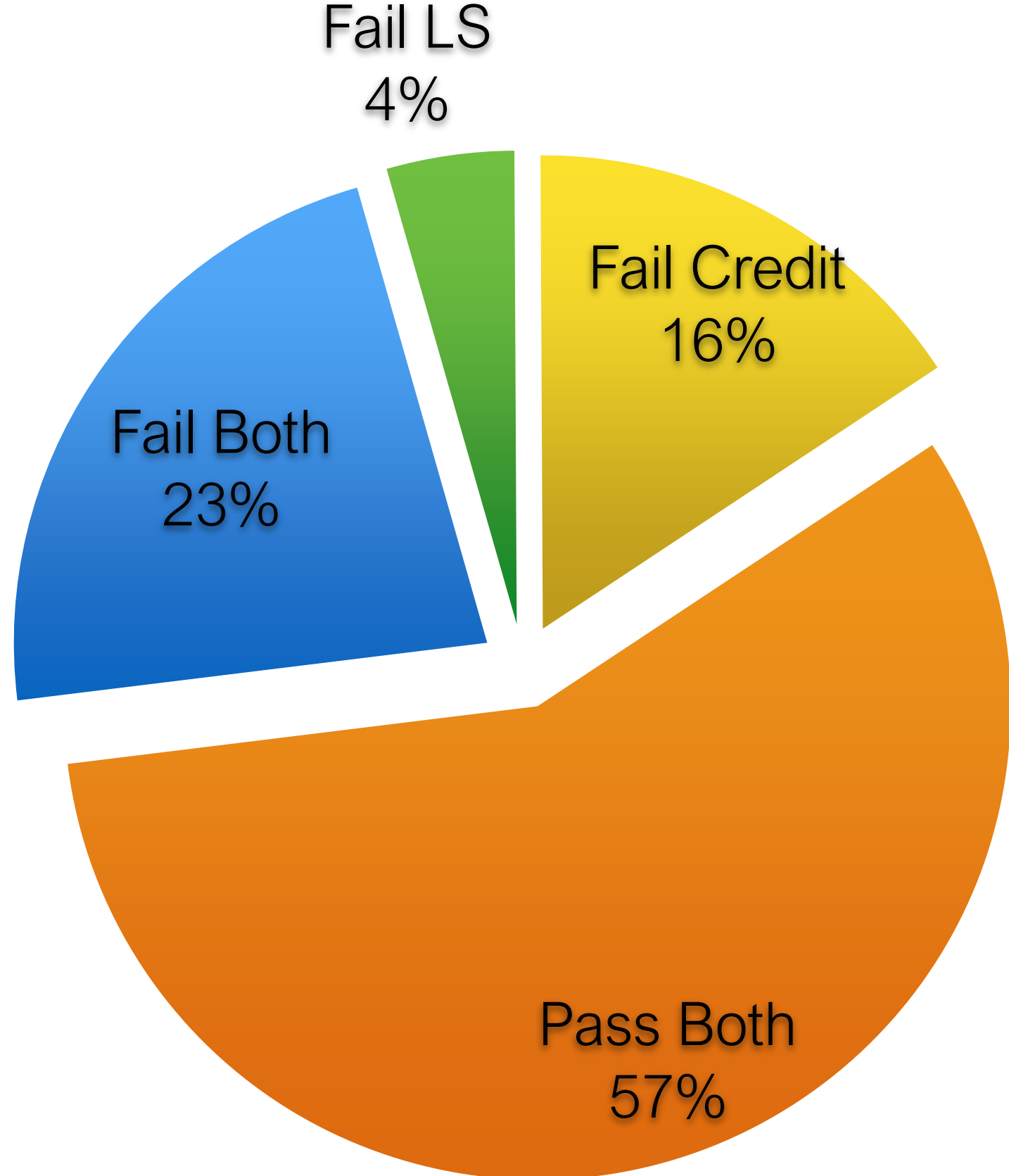

Disaggregation by Student Group

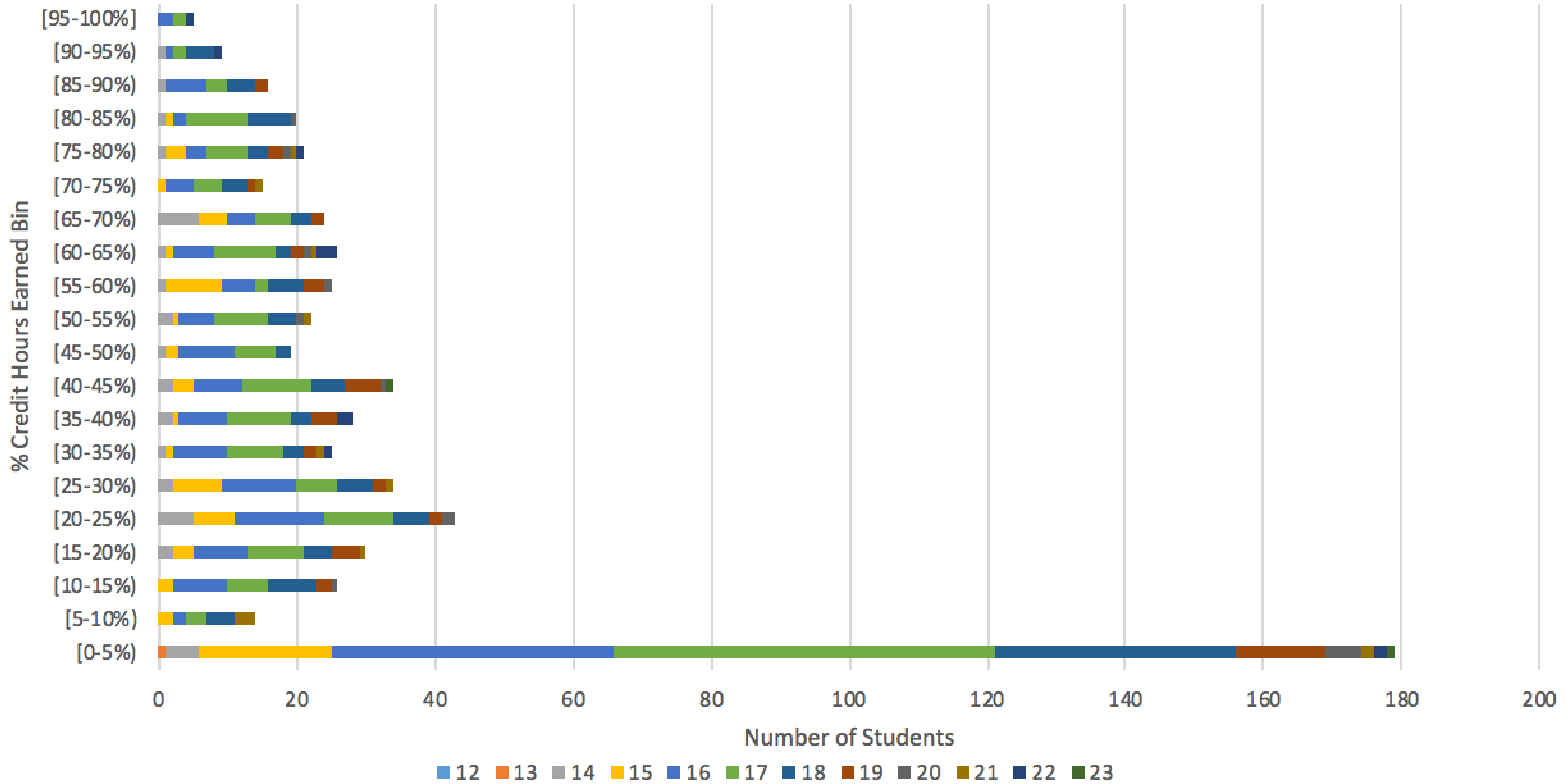

Failed Gateway, Failed Co-Req (C and above=Pass)

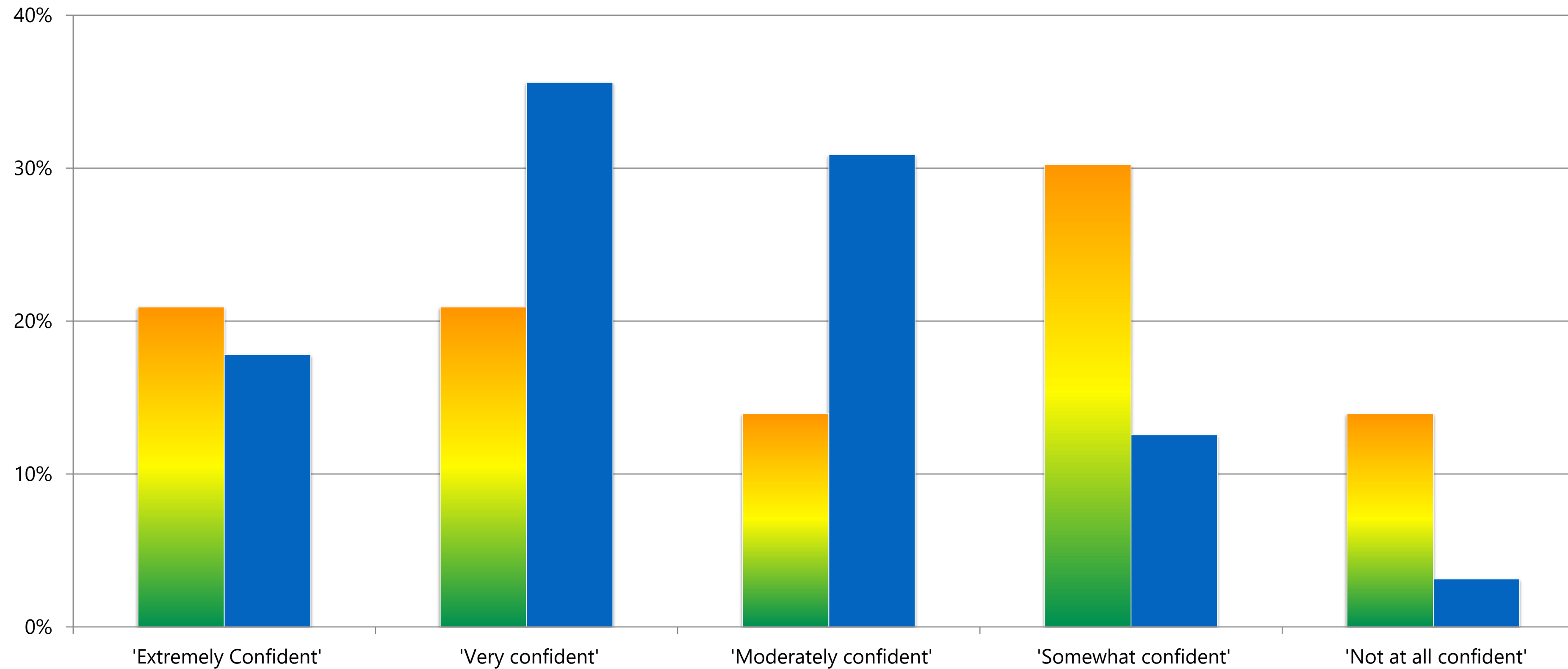

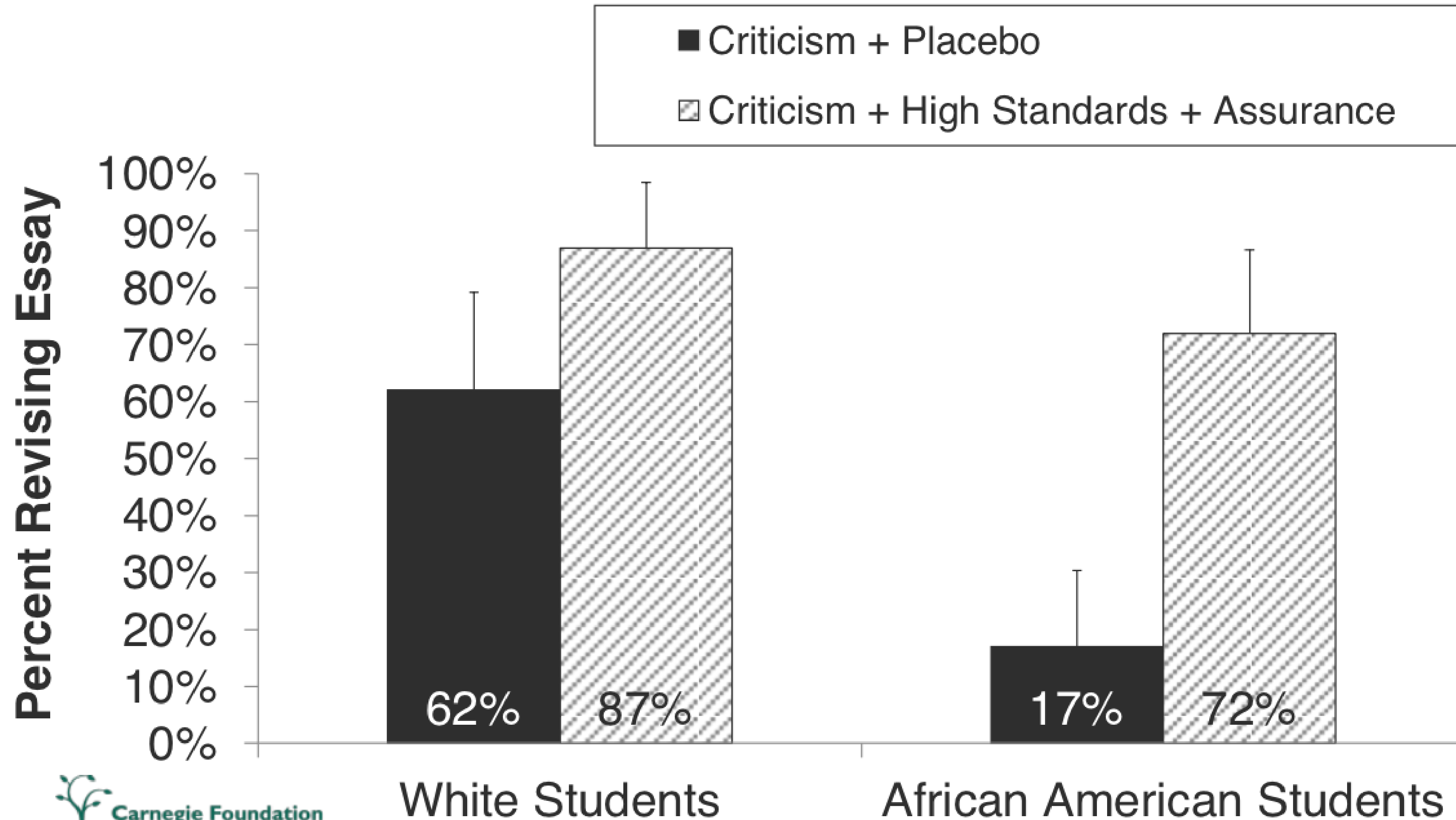

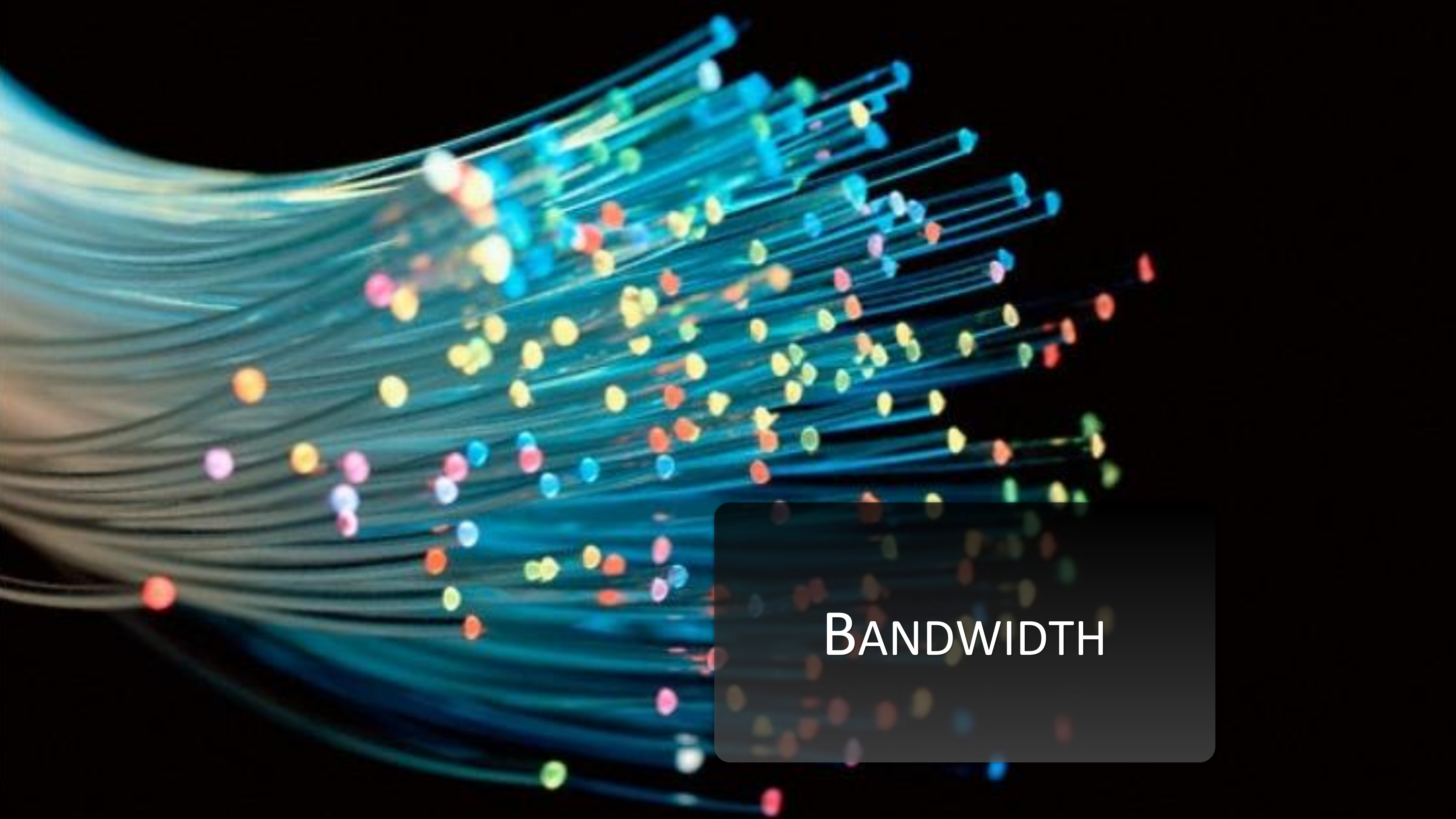

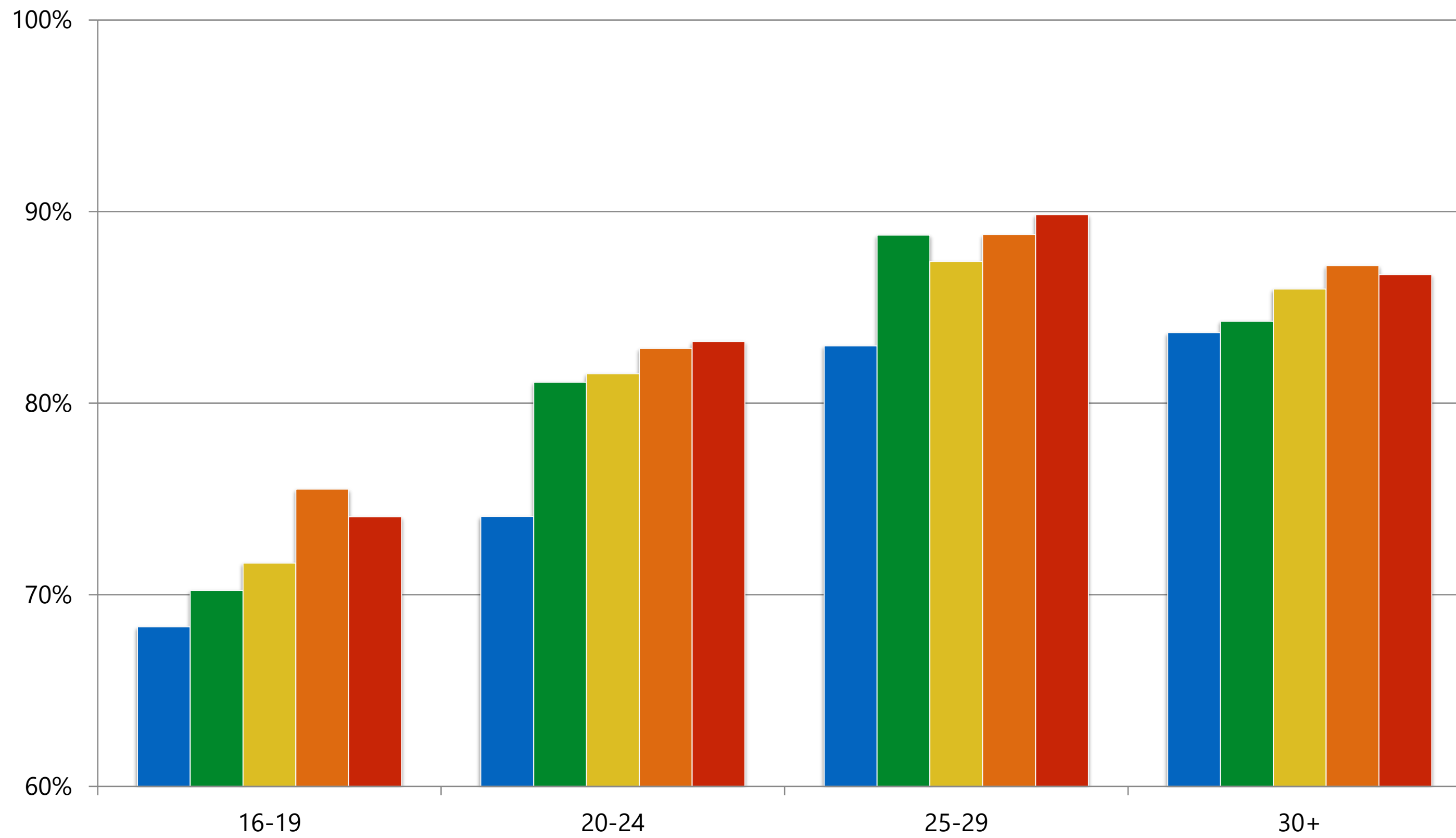
