




Persistence to Next Fall Semester by Academic Preparation Score and the 15 Credit Hour Breakpoint

Fall to Fall Persistence at Starting Campus First-Time Freshmen at the UH Community Colleges Fall 2009 to 2011 Cohorts




STAR-GPS automates the process and adds in default 15 credit academic maps







Full-time Freshmen Completing English and Math in the First Year







Freshmen Completing College Level English & Math by End of 1st Academic Year, Associate-Seeking, First-time, Full-time Students






Freshmen Completing College Level English & Math by End of 1st Academic Year, Associate-Seeking, First-time, Part-time Students






Full-time Freshmen Selecting a Major in the First Year








A student is considered to have a declared major if they are in a degree-seeking major but not in the following: Exploratory (EX), General - Undeclared (GEN), or General Arts and Sciences (GEAS). Students in Exploratory majors with a focus (e.g. Exploratory Business (EXB), Exploratory STEM (EXST), etc) are considered to have a declared major.


The retention rate of students that have at two or three of the measures is at 90% or higher







The on-time graduation rate for students with 2 to 3 measures is also 15 to 20 points higher
